



BLACK PAW MANUAL CHAIN HOIST-OPERATION INSTRUCTION

OPERATION INSTRUCTION

Before lifting, conduct a meticulous inspection of the hooks, load chain, brake device, and ensure proper lubrication of the block before initiating operation.

For safe operation, please be guided by the following:

- 1. Do not exceed the rated capacity of the chain block when lifting loads.
- 2. Refrain from raising a load excessively high.
- 3. Do not use if the chain is compromised.
- 4. Do not pass under a suspended load.
- 5. In the event that the hand chain becomes unresponsive, refrain from forcefully pulling or applying excessive force. Cease operation immediately and conduct a thorough inspection of the chain block.
- 6. Avoid letting the load get caught on any obstructions.

MAINTENANCE

- 1. After operation, clean the chain block to remove dirt and store it in a dry place to prevent rust and corrosion.
- 2. Annually clean the chain block by purging the parts in kerosene and apply grease. Skilled hands are recommended for cleaning.
- 3. Ensure that the "O" marks on the two disk gears are aligned.
- 4. Attach the rollers of both the left and right bearings to the inner race of the chain sprocket shaft journal's bearings, then place them into the outer race on the side plates.
- 5. When assembling the brake mechanism, pay attention to the mesh slanting teeth of the ratchet disc and the pawl. Ensure that the pawl is sensitive and reliable. Turn the hand wheel clockwise after screwing it into the driving shaft; it should press the disc and plates on the brake seat. Turning it counterclockwise should create clearance between the disc and plates.
- 6. The stay and the right side plate are in transition fit. Be cautious not to dismantle them.
- 7. After cleaning and repairing, subject the chain block to non-load and heavy load tests. If it operates normally, put it into use.
- 8. Keep the brake's friction surfaces clean while lubricating or operating the chain block. Frequently inspect the brake mechanism to prevent faulty braking or load falls.
- 9. For ease of maintenance and dismantling, one link of the hand chain is open, painted in one color, and not welded.


WARRANTY
